

## **Rhsa 2020-21 COVID-19 Policy Addendums**

**To allow RHSA use of the facility, the Temple requirements that pertain to everyone on the premises are as follows:**

1. RHSA families will be required to sign an additional statement of **waiver of liability for Covid-19**.
2. Everyone entering the building will receive a **temperature check** and **hand sanitizer** upon entrance. If the temperature is **above 100.2**, the person will not be permitted entrance and will be sent home. Person must be free of illness or asymptomatic. Anyone with confirmed exposure (Including all family members) will not be allowed entrance.
3. Everyone who enters the building will be checked in on an Attendance Roster.
4. Face coverings must be worn in the Temple and playground at all times. (face masks, face shields, neck gators, etc.). **At this time, preschool (4 yr) and older will be required to wear a face covering.** They can remove them in a classroom if the 6 ft safe-distancing is met, but preference is both face coverings and 6 ft safe-distancing.
5. Face coverings are required in all public areas such as hallways, bathrooms, social hall etc.
6. Maintain 6 ft safe-distancing.
7. Teachers will be opening and closing their classroom doors for a contactless entry and exit. Surfaces will be sanitized multiple times per day by the Temple staff and RHSA.
8. Classrooms tables and desks will be set up to maintain 6 ft safe-distancing
9. If a student, sibling, parent or teacher of RHSA tests positive, we will all be required to quarantine for 2 weeks. We will offer the high school classes online during that time. The elementary and jr high students may choose to *pause* for those two weeks and a credit will be given for the next month towards tuition.
10. Family/teen lounge will not be open. It will be unlocked to have access to the playground.
11. There will not be a playroom for babies & toddlers.
12. There will be at least two study halls available with safe-distancing seating for students
13. There are now 13 picnic tables available. They will be spaced out for safe-distancing. If you are with your family at a picnic table, no face mask is required.
14. The snack bar with prepackaged food and drinks will be available, but no hot meals sold. No coffee service.
15. **Playground:** At this time, face coverings will be **required** for preschool and older. Playground access will be through the family/teen lounge. The gate will remain locked.
16. **New Social Hall policy** due to safe-distancing and limited seating:
  - The social hall will have 20 round tables.
  - Tables will be placed 6 feet apart from each other.

- No sharing food with non-family members.
- The tables may only host one family at a time.
- We are creating a **Sign up genius** for the Social Hall that will ask for a time slot(s) So that we can serve multiple families. This is a one time sign-up genius to represent the school year
- There will be a **monthly Social Hall usage fee of \$10 per month.**
- ***After you register we will send you the email genius for table reservations***
- Parents that do not register for social hall may wait in the playground, picnic table, car or apply for **drop off.**

#### 17. New DROP OFF policy & application **updated 08/06/20**

**We would like to emphasize that RHSA is a family co-op. Because of COVID-19, we are allowing the option of dropping off elementary and jr high students for 2020-2021 ONLY. We are not a private school. We do not have staff to watch children in between classes and during lunch. By allowing this option, we have to enforce the following guidelines.**

- An application form will be sent to families of elementary and jr. high requesting drop off. This form will have you list their drop off times, open class periods, if staying for lunch - the signature of the adult in charge, and pick up time.
- There will be **no** drop off fee **but** parents will still be required to serve their volunteer hour. If you decide to opt out of serving it is \$300 fee.
  - A. Students may arrive up to 15 min before their first class of the day and will wait in a assigned study hall
  - B. Parent cannot leave campus until student has passed the temperature check
  - C. Students must be picked up no later than 15 minutes after their last class of the day. Students will wait in assigned study hall. A late fee will be charged of \$5 after 15 min and will increase for every 15 minutes.
  - D. At pick up, students must be signed out by parent or guardian.
  - E. Students cannot have more than 1 open class period between classes and will be assigned to a study hall during the open period. If there is a monitor on the playground then we will allow students to go to the playground. *(We prefer that there are no open periods between classes)*
  - F. Lunch period - Parent must return to campus or make an arrangement with a RHSA family on campus. RHSA requires the name of the family that is watching your child at lunchtime. Their signature will be required on the “drop off” application.
  - G. Rules A,B,C also apply to High School students. During an open class period, High School students may study in a study hall, go outside to the picnic tables or be at a pre-registered social hall table. If high school students self drive to school, then no parent is required to wait for temperature check.
  - H. If there is disciplinary situation, RHSA will follow our behavior policy in our handbook. (Found at [RHSA.org](http://RHSA.org))

Please note: The guidelines and protocols may change throughout the school year as pursuant to Temple policy. Regardless of the decisions of public schools, we will remain open unless Dallas county or the state of Texas issues orders to close. If forced closure happens, the option will be given to teachers and students to go virtual. Families that do not go virtual may be considered for a partial membership refund to be determined at time of closure.
